

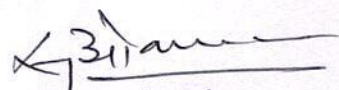

**Workshop on Competitive Examinations: Nature and Preparation**

Date : 19/03/2021

Initially, the plan was discussed with the principal along with IQAC and a proposal was submitted to the cluster lead college, Adarsh College Vita. The topic was finalized, and Lead College sanctioned the workshop. After that, the schedule of the workshop was finalised and communicated to the lead college as well as to students through notification and personal contacts. They were motivated to participate in it. The workshop took place on March 19th, 2021, in the seminar hall of the college. A total of 158 students and 6 faculty members participated in it. The workshop was conducted with the collaboration of the lead college. As resource persons, Hon. Rushikesh Shelake, Tehsildar Vita, and Hon. Pratiksha Bhute, Deputy Collector, were invited as resource persons. Dr. Hemangini Mane introduced the workshop and principal Dr. Sayajiraje Mokashi felicitated them. The chief guest, Mr. Rishikesh Shelake, spoke on planning and preparation for competitive examinations. He said continuity, perseverance, and constant study give bright success to students. He also suggested students read books in all fields, newspapers, and journals, and to think positively about life. Hon. Pratiksha Bhute suggested reading biographies of eminent personalities and following modern technology and interview techniques. See made them aware of their potential and abilities. 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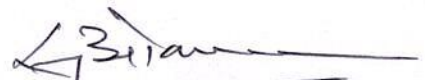
